

Niagara Celtic's Concert Lineup Announced

The 10th Annual Niagara Celtic Heritage Festival & Highland Games is less than two months away (September 18th and 19th) and the concert line-up is nearly complete. A wonderful variety of dancers, performers and bands will grace the festival's three concert venues throughout two full days.

Saturday's schedule kicks off at 10am with Ren Faire's favorite duo, *Merry Mischief*, and continues non-stop all day with performances by *Catch 'n Release*, *Reardon & Garvey*, *The Dady Brothers*, *Boughton Hill Band*, *The Dustmen* and more. Saturday night's Ceilidh (Kay-lee) concert will open with local favorite *Penny Whiskey*, followed by *The McMahon School of Irish Dance*. Headlining the Ceilidh is Vancouver greats' *The Town Pants*, who have garnered a near cult following in WNY and the Finger Lakes area. Their performance is sure to be one of the highlights of the weekend.

Sunday's schedule includes music from *Stone Row*, *Wild Geese*, *Schiehallion Scottish Dancers*, *Lochside Celtic* and *The Niagara Frontier Fiddle Club*. The grand finale of Niagara Celtic is a performance by Celtic rock legends *Seven Nations*.
